



Bits 'n Pieces

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Sewing Diagonal Squares

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This technique has many names -

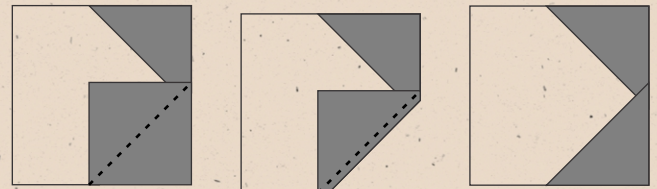
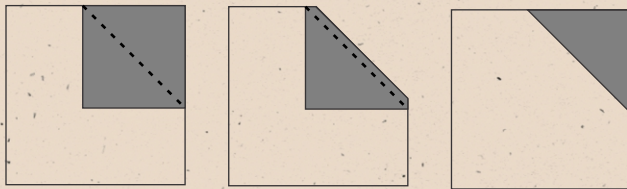
Diagonal Squares, Diagonal Corners, Flip and Sew and Snowball, to name a few.

Place a small fabric square of the corner of a large fabric square or rectangle. Sew diagonally.

Trim the seam to 1/4". Press.

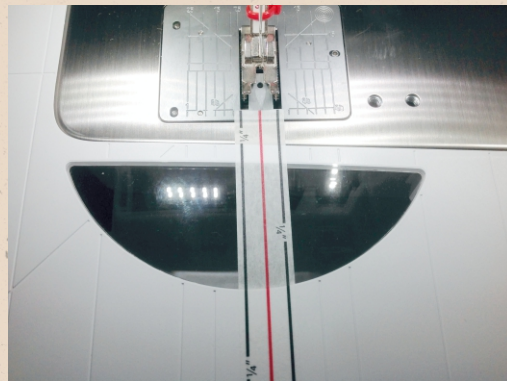
Place and sew on a second small fabric square.

Sew diagonally. Trim the seam. Press.

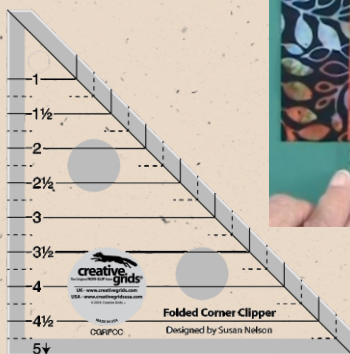


Helpful Tools:

Diagonal Seam Tape: Align the red line up with the needle. Place the square in the corner of the square and line up the edges. Line the top corner of the square up with the red line. Line up the bottom corner of the square on the red line. Start sewing at the top corner. Keep the bottom corner of the square on the red line the entire time and sew to the corner of the opposite square.



Folded Corner Clipper: No need to draw pencil lines! Simply trim the corner and use the raw edge as your seam guide.



Place the square on the corner (1). Using the Folded Corner Clipper, trim the corner (2). After trimming, stitch the edge using a 1/4" seam (3). Press to complete (4).
